Partner Seth Rubin Represents New Jersey Business Partners In \$1.4 Million Buyout of Third Partner's

Key real estate component of the deal ably handled by RMF real estate partner David Leno

- ➤ A New Jersey-based computer sales and service organization sought out RMF to help it implement a business buyout

- As required by the client, the deal was implemented swiftly, closing in less than two weeks
