Adam cofounded the CFO Roundtable in 2003, a by-invitation-only monthly gathering of CFOs from Long Island's leading private companies. Through these meetings, CFOs share best practices and discuss mutual business challenges, while building meaningful professional relationships. In guiding the growth of this organization, Adam has fostered a stimulating and rewarding environment that encourages collaboration and long-term networking.

In recognition of his leadership and professional achievements, Adam has been honored by Long Island Business News with its 40 Under 40 award (2006) and was inducted into LIBN's Hall of Fame in 2018. He has also been recognized on the City & State New York Long Island Power 100 List and by Long Island Business News as a Top 100 Long Islander, 60 Most Influential Long Islander, Most Influential Long Islander, Law Influencer, and Influencer in Law.

In addition, Adam serves on the Board of Directors of the Long Island Association and as its General Counsel.
