Durso expects to see increased oversight of health care transactions from the New York State Department of Health (DOH) in the wake of growing private equity investments in health care.

"Beginning on Aug. 1, 2023, New York will require health care entities, including physician practices and management services organizations, to disclose 'material transactions' to the DOH," Durso said. "Although the new law contains a de minimis exception and does not give the DOH approval authority, it allows the state to collect data on health care transactions and provide increased transparency in health care transactions."

"Health care entities need to be mindful of this new requirement, as failure to notify the DOH will subject the health care entity to a civil penalty of \$2,000 per day of non-compliance," he said.

Durso is admitted to practice law in the state of New York and the United States District

Court for the Eastern District of New York. He has been named as a New York Metro Super Lawyer, Rising Star in 2021 & 2022.
